Surveyor will be assisting in various types surveying and data collections. - Support and assist project team to collect data for various types of environmental studies, including active engagement in field visits, preparation of project reports and related documents.
- Ensure all the necessary equipment's, forms, maps and other materials needed in the field are in working order before travelling to the field.
- Development of necessary skills required in various fields to completed the designated tasks
- Routine maintenance of the survey instruments and equipment
